1.	To consider the letter dated 28.07.2018 received from Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate seeking entitlement to vote on the parity of orders passed by Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors." in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 dated 23.07.2018.	In this letter, Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate has requested that he be declared entitled to vote in NDBA, 2018 elections on the parity of decision of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors." The decision of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors." is confined to the petitioner in that Writ Petition in the peculiar facts and is therefore, not applicable in the case of Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate. Furthermore, an advance copy of the Writ Petition titled as Praveen Mishra vs. NDBA & Ors. was received by this Committee where the petitioner had prayed to be declared as entitled to vote on the parity with the judgment of Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of Shailendra Kumar Singh (supra). But Sh. Praveen Mishra has not mentioned the outcome of the said Writ Petition in his letter dated 28.07.2018. However, the Hon'ble Delhi

		High Court website shows that the said Writ Petition was registered as WP(C) 7788/2018 and on 27.07.2018, the same was dismissed as withdrawn. Therefore, _____ Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate is not entitled to vote in NDBA, 2018 elections.
2.	Letter dated 30.07.2018 written by the Hony. Secy., NDBA requesting to consider the request of Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate to declare him entitled to vote.	The request of Sh. Praveen Mishra, Advocate has already been dealt with above and no further consideration by the Committee is required.
3.	Letters dated 30.07.2018 from Sh. Sanjiv Prakash Upadhyaya and Sh. Mansha Ram Singh, Advocates requesting to declare them entitled to vote.	In these letters, Sh. Sanjiv Prakash Upadhyaya and Sh. Mansha Ram Singh, Advocates have requested that in the light of decision of Hon'ble Delhi Court in the case of the "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors." in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 dated 23.07.2018, they be also declared entitled to vote. In the case of Shailendra Kumar Singh (supra) the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has held that the order is confined to the petitioner in the Writ Petition in the peculiar facts. Resultantly, the representations of Sh. Sanjiv Prakash Upadhyaya and Sh. Mansha Ram Singh, Advocates cannot be acceded to on the grounds of parity with the directions given in the case of Shailendra Kumar Singh (supra).
4.	Addendum to the list of members of NDBA found entitled to vote in NDBA, 2018 elections.	This Committee vide minutes dated 16.07.2018, 19.07.2018, 24.07.2018 and 28.07.2018 has already declared Sh. Manish Kumar, Sh. H. N. Gupta, Sh. Pratap Ranjan, Sh. Rajinder Kumar Ahuja and Sh. Shailendra

Kumar Singh, respectively, entitled to vote in elections of NDBA, 2018. The names of these five members shall stand deleted from the list of members prepared by this Election Committee and found "not entitled to vote" at serial no.437, 10, 374, 265 & 118.






