Patiala House Complex. The place is not suitable to meet the growing needs of District Court in the coming years.

- It has been mentioned that only 40 Court Rooms are under construction at Rouse Avenue, whereas, in Patiala House Complex already 40 Court Rooms are functioning.
- If the shifting of Courts initiated, only a part of the Court
 Complex i.e. the Court Rooms will be vacated/shifted and
 the half of the Court Complex i.e. Lawyers Chambers will
 remain here since there are no arrangement for providing
 sufficient number of Chambers in the proposed new
 location at Rouse Avenue.
- This is a mere waste of Public Money and there is no scope for future expansion at Rouse Avenue.
- This will create an awkward situation and defeat the very purpose of shifting the Courts.
- It is point out that Building Maintenance & Construction
 Committee (Rouse Avenue Court Complex) comprising the
 Hon'ble Judges of Delhi High Court noted that the area
 under construction is inadequate. The BMCC in its meeting
 held on 07/10/2015 has directed for allotment of adjacent
 1.4 acres land in addition to the plot where construction is
 underway.

We have reitrated our resolve that there is no need to shift the New Delhi District Courts to another place and continue to oppose the shifting of Courts from Patiala House Complex since Patiala House Complex has all facilities,
