Sub: Suggestion for setting up more Polling Booths
and other facilities for the scheduled Election
of Bar Council of Delhi

Respected Sir

We wish to bring it to your kind attention that the setting up of one polling station for the Bar Council of Delhi on 16th and 17th of January, 2018 will create unnecessary chaos in casting the votes, since there are about 51,000 voters and it is expected that atleast 16 to 18 thousand voters will turn up on each polling day. Considering the Delhi High Court, it is not so spacious to hold such a large election in view of the quantity of voters.

In previous elections as a central place Tis Hazari Courts used to be the only polling station. In the last election there were two booths one at Tis Hazari Courts and another at Delhi High Court.

At present there is considerable increase in the number of voters. In view of this, it is suggested that there should be one polling booth in all the six District Courts i.e. Tis Hazari, Patiala House Courts, Karkardooma, Rohini, Saket and Dwarka and one each in the Delhi High Court and the Supreme Court of India.

It is pertinent to mention here that in the Elections for the Governing body of C.A. and C.S. etc., preferential voting system is adopted in setting polling station in different locations for the convenience of voters.

The voters list can be bifurcated as per the pin code number of the voter as given in the Voters List. On the basis of the pin code numbers the voter will be assigned the nearest District Court to cast his/her vote. This will

certainly ease out the traffic problem and will convenient and time saving for the voter.

Fifty one thousand voters coming to one place to cast their vote will certainly lead to traffic jams and will be time consuming for the voter. This kind of inconvenience will prevent the voter in casting their votes. Further it will take approximately 4 to 5 minutes to cast a vote as the ballot paper will be lengthy in size since there are large number of contestants.

The polling time should be between 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM for the convenience of the voters and issue the latest Identity Cards to the Members, since the charges for the I. Cards have already been collected.

Further it is suggested that a formatted Bio-Date of all the contesting candidates be circulated amongst the voters by way of postal mail or e-mail, as "Know Your Candidate" and will be a great help for the voters to identify the right choice and casting the vote in the polling booth without delay. In our view if the above suggestion implemented then percentage votes will be considerably increase.

Kindly do the needful at the earliest.
