3rd of February, 2017 CIRCULAR REGARDING CHAMBER & SITTING SPACE

Hon'ble Members are hereby informed that on 22/09/2015, New Delhi Bar Association had issued notices to 38 allottees to vacate their Chambers which were found to be allotted without following any due process or eligibility criteria by the Chamber Scrutiny Committee under the Chairmanship of Sh. M.K. Sharma, Advocate which was constituted as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

There have been litigations against the allotment of Chambers in the Hon'ble High Court and District Courts since 2014 and in the year 2016 three Writ Petitions were filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. Now, the Hon'ble High Court in a common order dated 19/01/2017 in the three cases i.e. W.P.(C) No. 4817/2016 in the name and style of Yatendra Singh Vs State of NCT of Delhi & Ors, W.P. (C) No.4585/2016 in the name and style of Manju Kasana Vs.State of NCT of Delhi & Ors and W.P.(C) 6765/2016 in the name and style of Suman Kumar Tyagi Vs. New Delhi Bar Association & Anr., has directed the New Delhi Bar Association to expedite the process initiated, consequent to the notice dated 22/09/2015.

As per the Hon'ble High Court order, New Delhi Bar Association has again issued notices to 30 allottees to vacate their Chambers/Seats.

In Continuation of Chamber/Seat issue, it is stated that:-1. If any member who has been received notices, aggrieved that his/her allotment is in proper order, then kindly submit the valid reasons in writing at the Bar Office.
